

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Cabinet Memorandum on the National Council for Older Persons Bill 2010 has been examined as required under S.10 of the Budget Act.

I wish to report as follows:

a) That the Memorandum has the following Objective

 To provide for the establishment of a National Council for Older Persons that will coordinate various stakeholders involved in the implementation programmes for older persons and consequently improve their livelihoods.

b) That the Expected Outputs are:

- Legislation and Programming for older persons enacted in accordance with the Constitution.
- Participation, influence and decision making by older persons in planning processes and policies that directly affect their well being.
- Election of representatives for older persons at all levels through free and fair elections.

c) Planned Expenditure over the MTEF period:

 The planned expenditure for the National Council is Shs 1.41bn annually with Shs 0.9bn allocated to district grants to cater for local government councils for older persons. This expenditure will be accommodated within the Medium Term Expenditure Framework for the Ministry of Gender, Labour and Social Development.

d) Funding and Budgetary implications

 There are no additional financial implications to the Government of Uganda.

e) Expected savings and/or Revenue to government

 There are no savings expected from the operationalisation of the National Council of Older Persons Bill 2010
