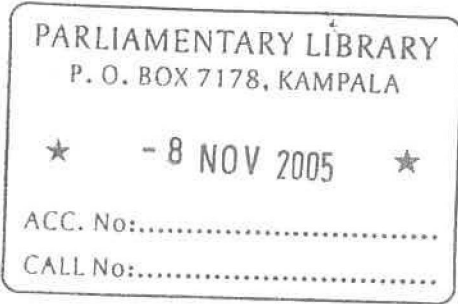

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**
(made under S.10 of the Budget Act)

This is to certify that the Bill entitled, **LABOUR DISPUTES (ARBITRATION AND SETTLEMENT) BILL, 2005** has been examined as required under S.10 of the Budget Act. I wish to report as follows:

(a) That the Bill has the following objective:

To operationalise mechanisms of handling labour disputes and permits strike action to take place where the mechanism has been followed. It sets out the Industrial Court as the apex of trade disputes settlements and lifts it to the level of the High Court. It allows a group of workers as well as individuals to bring disputes to the Industrial Court. It gives a reduced time frame for disposal of disputes. It seeks to repeal the current trade Disputes (Arbitration and Settlement) Act Cap 224.

(b) That the Expenditure Plan by major components for the next two years shall be accommodated within the Medium Term Expenditure Framework for FY's 2005/06-2007/08.

(c) That the funding and budgetary implications arising out of implementation of the Bill are NIL.

(d) No savings and /or revenue to Government are expected in the FY 2005/06.
