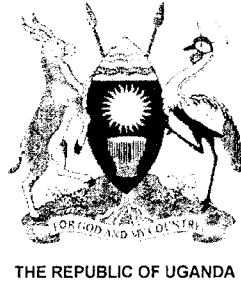


d) Impact on the economy.

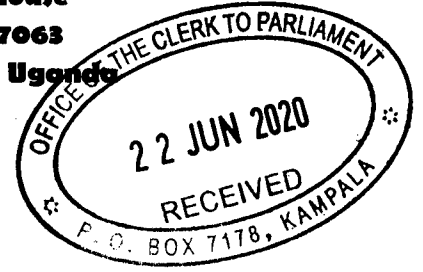
