THE FIREARMS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2004.

MEMORANDUM.

The object of this Bill is to make miscellaneous amendments in the Firearms Act, (Cap. 299) in order to strengthen the penalties in that Act with a view to combating and providing a sufficient deterrent against offences involving possession and use and of firearms.

Finally, references in the Bill to Acts and sections of Acts in existence before the year 2001 which are now contained in the Revised Edition of the Laws of Uganda which was brought into force on 1st October, 2003 by Statutory Instrument No. 69 of 2003 issued the Attorney General, are now adapted to read as references to the corresponding sections and chapters as contained in the new Revised Edition.

An Act to amend the Firearms Act.

Be it enacted by Parliament as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment) Short title. Act, 2004.
