THE NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANISATIONS REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1991.

This Bill seeks to amend the Non-Governmental Organisations Registration Statute, 1989 so as to empower the responsible Minister to extend the period within which Non-Governmental Organisations existing on the date of coming into force of that Statute may be registered, having regard to the fact that the original time limit for their registration expired before the National Board for Non-Governmental Organisations commenced its operations.

A BILL for a Statute

ENTITLED

THE NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANISATIONS REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) STATUTE, 1991.

A Statute to amend the Non-Governmental Organisations Registration Statute, 1989 so as to empower the Minister responsible to extend the period within which Non-Governmental Organisations existing on the date of coming into force of the Statute may be registered.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and the National Resistance Council as follows:

1. This Statute may be cited as the Non-Governmental Organisations Registration (Amendment) Statute, 1991, and shall be read as one with the Non-Governmental Organisations (Registration) Statute, 1989 and be deemed to have come into force on the 29th day of October, 1989.

Short title and commence-ment.

2. Section 1 of the Non-Governmental Organisations (Registration) Statute, 1989 is amended by adding at the end of subsection (4) the following words—

"or within such other period after that date as the Minister may, by statutory instrument, prescribe.".
