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A BILL for a Statute

ENTITLED

**THE SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION
(FINANCIAL YEAR 1993/94) STATUTE, 1994.**

A Statute to apply a further sum of Shs. 42,162,506,000 out of the Consolidated Fund to the service of the year ended on the 30th June, 1994 and to appropriate the supplies granted.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and the National Resistance Council as follows :

1. This Statute may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (Financial Year 1993/94) Statute, 1994. Short title.

2. The Treasury may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply towards the supply granted to the Government for the service of the year ended on 30th June, 1994, the sum of Shs. 42,162,506,000. Issue of money out of the Consolidated Fund.

3. The sums granted by section 2 shall be appropriated to the purposes specified in the second column of the Schedule and in the amounts specified in the third and fourth columns of the Schedule. Appropriation.
